

1. Team Tournament Results 0.67 to 0.47

One of the most improved teams in the world and the most improved team in Asia from a results perspective - HK Team Performance in International tournaments from 2010-2016 **averaged 0.67** (2/3rds of the way down the field) with a trendline that was not improving. From 2016 -2018 (total 18 team events Male/Female) the team averaged 0.47.

2. One player to 5 male players in top 1000 of the world

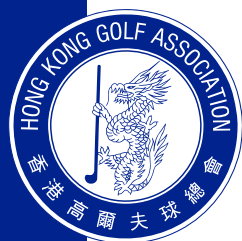
In Jan 2016 there was one male player in top 1000 of World Rankings (Matthew Cheung at 913). Now there are 5 players (Ben Wong 80, Leon D'Sousa 580, Terrence Ng 742, Taichi Kho 889, Matthew Cheung 921).

3. Improvement in ALL 7 stages of the Player Funnel

From 2014 to 2016 the overall Funnel growths were neutral (near 0%). From 2016 to 2018 ALL stages of the Player Funnel improve and the **average growth was +80%**.

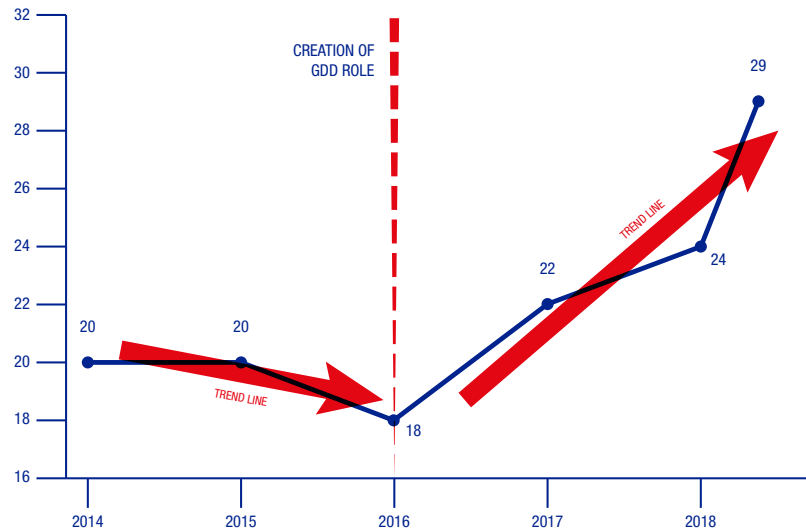

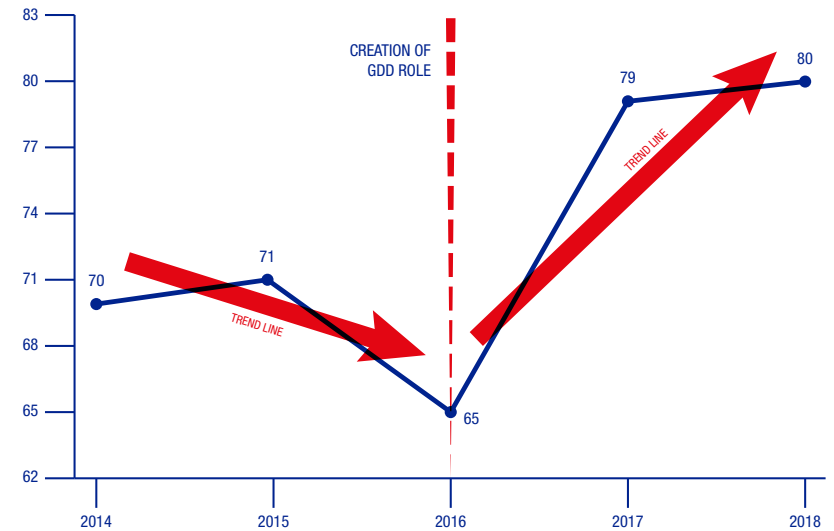

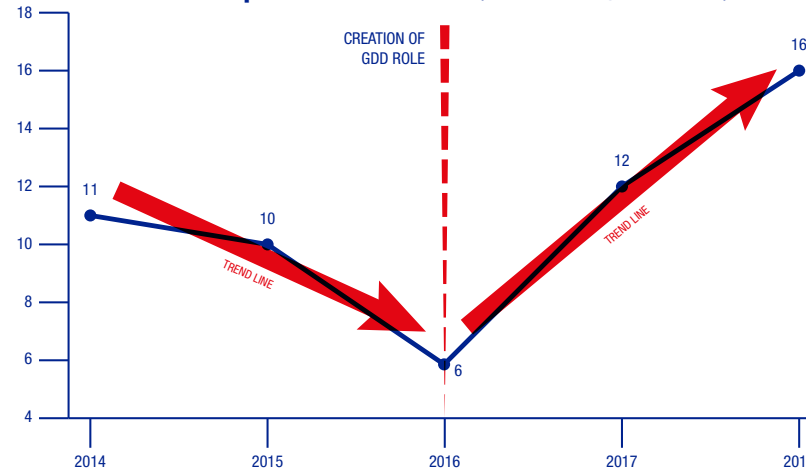

H'Cap 4.9 or less (under 15 years old)

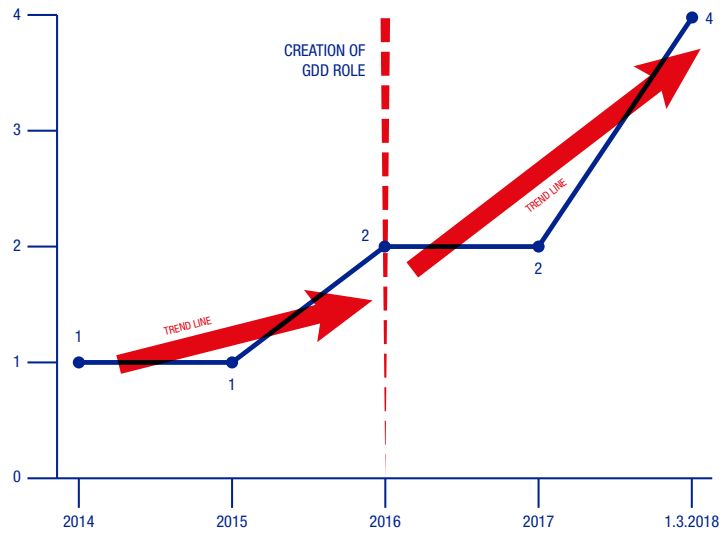

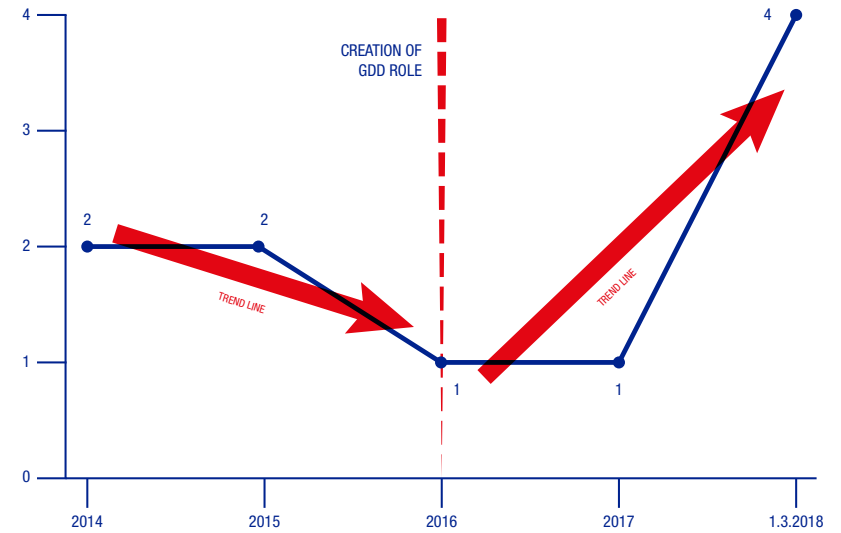

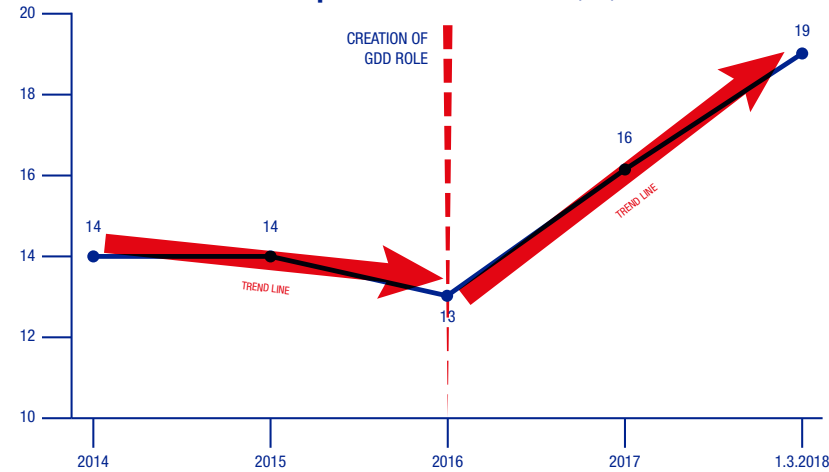
TOP 500 (amateur & pro)

1. Advisory Council –

This was initiative to allow key people in the HK golf landscape be able to give feedback and input into the Player Development Program strategy. So this included Directors of Golf, Head Professional's and Club Managers.

2. HKGA Contracted Coaching Team

From 3 coaches with 30% class cancellation to 12 local coaches with 0% class cancellation and 300% increase in coaching classes from 2015 to 2018. Throughout the season we had regular 'in-house' coaching days in order to work together as a Coaching Team, as well as certifying over 80 local HKPGA courses in the GA Coach Development Program.

3. Consultant Team

World renowned consultants Dr Brian Hemmings (Lead Psychologist for England Golf for 17 years developing players such as Danny Willett, Tommy Fleetwood, Ross Fisher and Chris Wood) and 3D Biomechanics expert Ryan Lumsden (over long period of time worked with players like Henrik Stenson, Thomas Pieters, Minjee Lee, Lydia Ko, Nasa Hataoka etc)

4. HK Talent Team and HK Junior Talent Team

Developed a coaching program to accelerate the development of the leading 12 players and the leading 12 players 11 to 16 years old (Junior Team).

5. HKGA Scorecard

Previously there was no instrument to measure KPIs so we developed the 'Scorecard whereby all 7 stages of the Player Funnel are measured every 3 months.



The HKGA Contracted Coach Team was formed by Jon and received regular training to create a network of local HKPGA Coaches to deliver more local coaching classes

Taichi Kho:

From a quantitative standpoint, Jon has taken the Hong Kong National Team to the upper echelons of competitive golf in South East Asia. Prior to Spring 2016, there was only one male National Team representative within the top 1000 of the World Amateur Golf Rankings (WAGR), with Matthew Cheung at 900. Currently, there are five male National Team members within the top 1000 of the WAGR, with three of these players ranked within the top 800 of the WAGR ranking system. These statistics accompanied with tournament finishes of 7th in the Asia Pacific Amateur Golf Team Championship, 4th in the Men's and Ladies World University Team Championship, 4th in the Chinese National

Games, and 9th at the World Universidad in Taiwan undoubtedly represents the positive quantitative impact Jon has had on the team. These recent successes are a direct outcome of the collaborative effort between Jon and the National Team. With individualized focus, Jon has allowed every player to continuously progress on areas to improve for their specific needs. Personally, Jon and I have mainly focused on the mental aspect of competitive golf. I have lowered my scoring average from approximately 74 to 71 within the past 2 years with an improving trend. Jon's knowledge of golf and passion to help Hong Kong has made him not only one of the best National Team coaches in the Asia Pacific region, but one of the best in the world. His passion for golf has inspired every player to become a better golfer and a better person."
